



## **Charter to the Dayton Region Priority Development and Advocacy Committee (PDAC) From the Dayton Development Coalition**

**I. Establishment and Purpose.** The Dayton Region Priority Development and Advocacy Committee (PDAC) is established as a committee of the Dayton Development Coalition to assist in establishing regional legislative priorities.

**II. Chair.** The PDAC Chair shall be appointed by the Dayton Development Coalition to serve a three-year term, subject to reappointment.

**III. Membership.** The members shall be appointed by the Dayton Development Coalition to represent business, government, educational, or civic organizations; or for their expertise. Members shall be appointed to ensure the maximum diversity within race, gender, and age and to represent the major geographical regions of the Dayton Region. Members shall be appointed to serve a one-year term, subject to reappointment.

**IV. Meetings.** The PDAC shall meet once or more a year, subject to the call of the Chair.

**V. Rules.** The PDAC shall establish its own rules for procedure.

**VI. Amendment.** This Charter may be amended by the Dayton Development Coalition. Changes will be affective upon publication on the Coalition's Web site.
