Dear Mr. Hoagland,

The purpose of my letter, is to request your consideration and support for PDAC funding for the West Carrollton River District and Whitewater Park Project. This project represents a unified vision of the West Carrollton City Council, to redevelop the I-75/Exit 47 Interchange into a vibrant destination location. The City of West Carrollton commissioned Pros Sports Consulting to perform a market analysis and economic impact study of the West Carrollton Whitewater Park. The market analysis concluded that West Carrollton Whitewater Park can attract over 100,000 visitors annually. Further, it will serve as the centerpiece for the planned \$75 million-dollar mixed use development, immediately adjacent to Exit 47.

The City of West Carrollton has made significant progress in advancing the project. We are currently in the process of completing a lease arrangement with the Miami Conservancy District for the proposed park area adjacent to the West Carrollton low-dam site. The Whitewater Park Design team of Merrick Engineering/Mclaughlin Whitewater Group, is developing the engineering design features that will transform the existing low-head dam into a premier watersport destination location for visitors and enthusiasts from a broad geographic area.

The City of West Carrollton has currently committed in excess of \$6 million dollars of its financial resources to the project. Further, our public sector funding partners, which include Federal, State and County government, have also provided an additional \$4 million dollars in funding to date. This 2023/2024 PDAC funding request will ensure that the West Carrollton River and Whitewater Park moves forward expediently and successfully. The City of West Carrollton recently allocated over \$2.5 million dollars in city funds for gateway roadway improvements, that will serve the River Park District. Roadway construction will commence during the 2024 construction season. We are also on pace to begin improvements to the low-head dam during the 2025 construction season.

In closing, the City of West Carrollton is fully committed to the successful completion of this project. I appreciate your past support and respectfully request your continued support for the project as we move forward.


