



According to the *National Association of Sports Commissions Economic Impact Calculator*, the economic impact is estimated at \$3.4 million annually from spectators and participants for a championship like event. Like facilities have garnered between \$3 million and \$10 million of real economic impact dollars per year. Specifically, in Warren County, the Courts of Sports located in Mason realizes approximately \$6.5 million in economic impact annually (per Ben Huffman, Warren County Convention & Visitors' Bureau). This Center would yield significant economic development and community outreach that would grow Clinton County exponentially. Finally, community access to the facility will enhance the quality of life for community members from youth to the elderly who currently have limited facilities for indoor exercise activities during inclement weather.




